Fact or Opinion?

Be sure that your child understands that a fact is a statement that can be proven to be true and that an opinion is a statement that is not based on proven information.

Have your child use each spelling word to write a statement of fact and a statement of opinion. Then read each pair of statements with your child and discuss the differences between them.
