Dear Family,

Ask your child to write the spelling words correctly on the blank lines. As you work with your child to practice this week's spelling words, try the following activity.

Guessing Game
Write on small cards twenty spelling words your child is having trouble with. Deal them facedown to each of you. Each player should take turns giving a clue for one of the spelling words in his or her hand. Clues could include synonyms, related words, and rhyming words. If the word is guessed after one clue, give 5 points; after two clues, 3 points; after three clues, 1 point. After each player guesses a word, he or she should write it on a separate piece of paper.
