Dear Family,

Ask your child to write the spelling words correctly on the blank lines. As you work with your child to practice this week's spelling words, try the following activity.

**Anagrams** Use letter tiles from games or magnetic letters you may have at home for this activity. If you do not have letter tiles at home, have your child write spelling words on cards and then cut the letters apart. Have your child use all the letters in a spelling word and manipulate them to form different words. For example, the word *regal* can be rearranged to form *glare*, and *docile* can be turned into *coiled*.
