Dear Family,

Ask your child to write the spelling words correctly on the blank lines. As you work with your child to practice this week's spelling words, try the following activity.

Board Game Play a board game according to the rules. At the beginning of your child's turn, pronounce one of the spelling words and have your child spell it aloud or write it on a piece of paper. If your child spells the word correctly, he or she may have an extra turn. If the word is spelled incorrectly, your child loses his or her turn. Tell or show your child the correct spelling and have him or her repeat it or write it before continuing.
