Ask your child to write the spelling words correctly on the blank lines. As you work with your child to practice this week's spelling words, try the following activity.

Type-a-Word Most children enjoy typing on a real or play typewriter or on a computer keyboard. This can lead to especially valuable spelling practice since searching for and striking each letter key focuses attention on the order of letters in a word. Pronounce each word and have your child type it. Another time, have your child type the list of spelling words. Check the spellings of the words with your child.
