Purpose:


Learn about letter shape through physical activity

Materials:

sidewalk chalk or masking tape

Choose several manuscript letters that students are learning. Use sidewalk chalk to write them very large on the playground or use masking tape to form them on the floor of your classroom.

Invite students to walk, hop, or skip along the lines of the letters. Ask them to point out the four kinds of lines that make up manuscript letters: horizontal lines, vertical lines, circle lines, and diagonal lines.



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
