





One day Lily and Ettabetta spotted some new things in the closet. There were three bent train tracks, a toy duck with one wheel missing, and a boat with a ripped sail.







The horse had a long mane and tail. It had a wide smile. But it had no eyes. Lily and Ettabetta liked the horse very much.

"I only have one dime."


"I have a dime!" said Lily. "Let's put your dime and my dime together and get the black beads."
